



**Action Plan for 2024-2026 to the National Concept for Preventing and Ending Homelessness by 2030 (AP
NK PUB)**

Homelessness and housing exclusion are the most extreme manifestations of poverty and social exclusion. Preventing and ending homelessness is essential to the successful functioning of the welfare state. The approval of the National Concept for Preventing and Ending Homelessness by 2030 by Resolution 158 of 12 April 2023 can thus be seen as the result of a long-term effort by the professional community to highlight the need for a more proactive approach to systemic solutions. The Framework is an overarching strategic document defining global and specific goals in each key area, concrete measures and activities to prevent and end homelessness (<https://www.employment.gov.sk/files/sk/rodina-socialna-pomoc/socialne-sluzby/prevencia-ukoncovanie-bezdomovstva/narodna-koncepcia-prevencie-ukoncovania-bezdomovstva.pdf>).

At the national level, the involvement of a wide range of public and private stakeholders, including local and regional authorities, as well as relevant NGOs in the development and implementation of strategies to combat homelessness and housing exclusion is essential. Strong inter-agency cooperation helps to better identify and address the multiple and distinct needs of homeless people, which are characterised by their intersectionality across all spheres of life. This is also why the Action Plan aims to ensure the implementation of at least one specific action in each of the identified areas.

The essence of ending homelessness in the context of an integrated strategy is that every homeless person should have the opportunity to address their situation, obtain affordable housing and integrate into life, with appropriate support, in a timely manner.

In the context of the Slovak Republic, the above understanding of ending homelessness as a set of measures aimed at supporting homeless people to regain and maintain housing and preventing people at risk from losing their homes represents a new approach to tackling homelessness. On the one hand, many of the existing measures to help homeless people have not even explicitly focused on this target group. At the same time, they have not been clearly targeted and systemically linked. Limited access to housing, or the lack of affordable rental housing and the consequent impossibility of linking it to social services for crisis intervention, has the effect of perpetuating rather than ending homelessness. There are several arguments in favour of an integrated strategy to end homelessness: the starting point for ending homelessness is the promotion and implementation of fundamental human rights.

The global objective of the National Approach to Preventing and Ending Homelessness is in line with the Lisbon Strategy:

❖ **End homelessness in Slovakia by 2030 so that**

- **No one is sleeping rough due to lack of accessible, safe and adequate emergency accommodation;**
- **No one stays in emergency or transitional accommodation for longer than is necessary for a successful transition to permanent housing;**
- **No one has been released from a prison, hospital, social services facility or other institution without being offered suitable housing;**
- **Forced evictions are prevented as far as possible and, if they do occur, assistance is made available to secure suitable housing where necessary;**
- **No one is discriminated against for being homeless.**

An outcome arising from the Strategy is the development of the submitted NCPUB Action Plan 2024-2026 and subsequently the Action Plan 2027-2030. It will be prepared in cooperation with the relevant central government authorities, local government, representatives of the non-governmental sector and all other entities active in the field of homelessness. The Action Plan shall be developed over a period of up to five years, so as to allow for a flexible response to the realities of society and homeless people. It elaborates global and partial objectives into measures and activities with defined measurable indicators, responsible promoters and partners and identification of the necessary financial requirements and appropriate resources to cover them. The implementation of the actions of the Action Plan will be evaluated annually by the responsible bodies and the individual task holders. The Action Plan designs the tasks in line with other related national strategic framework documents as well as other international commitments, including e.g. the Lisbon Declaration on the European Platform on Combating Homelessness (2021), which states that “homelessness is one of the most extreme forms of social exclusion, negatively affecting people’s physical and mental health, well-being, and quality of life, as well as their access to employment and access to other economic and social services”.

Monitoring

The implementation of the measures in the Action Plan, fulfilling the objectives resulting from the approved strategy, is linked to the need to monitor their bringing into operation and to assess the fulfilment of the measurable indicators of their performance. This process provides reliable feedback on how the objectives and individual measures have been set, as well as on the actual impact on the target groups. Monitoring and evaluation will be carried out in cooperation with stakeholders, defined as the actors involved in the implementation of the individual measures, or partners and other relevant actors concerned. Monitoring and evaluation will focus in particular on assessing the progress of the implementation of the measures against the values of the output indicators. Monitoring and evaluation will be carried out in line with the time horizon of the strategy on at least a biennial basis or as identified needs arise. A report on the implementation of the measures and tasks resulting from the Strategy will be submitted to the Government of the Slovak Republic as an information document. Tasks that cannot be completed in 2024-2026 or are to be continued beyond 2026 will be implemented in the Action Plan 2027-2030 after review. Beyond the formal monitoring, a meeting of promoters and cooperating partners will be convened at least semi-annually to provide information on the ongoing implementation of activities.
